	 Finance Update (Leesman) Budget with monthly actuals YTD (thru December) +\$3,688.42 January expenses to date include Pancake Breakfast, Fun Lunch, Teacher Grants Expenses are tracking below budget. We need to increase student spending (field trips, assemblies, etc) and order additional outdoor equipment from excess playground funds. Pancake breakfast was a money maker, but budgeted to break even. Experiences have been significant money makers - Thank you to the hosts! The hosts cover all expenses as a donation so 100% of ticket price proceeds go to the PTA. Tax extension approved by IRS. 2022-2023 tax return is more complicated due to playground fundraising. State & Local PTA dues are paid and required insurance renewed. These total ~\$1,300.
